Pony Express Rider

At the center of the design is a Pony Express rider galloping across the frontier. The rider is moving westward, symbolizing exploration, progress, and the pioneering spirit that shaped America.

Patriotic Sky

The blue sky is formed by sweeping red and white cloud bands. The flowing clouds create a sense of movement, echoing the speed and urgency of the Pony Express.

Winding River

The river represents the mighty Missouri River, which flows through the heart of the council's territory. Like Scouting, every journey begins with a first step, and for the Pony Express that journey began here.

America 250 Emblem

The America 250 emblem is set within a golden sunset, representing the westward journey of the Pony Express and honoring the generations of Americans who have helped shape our nation's first 250 years.

Legendary Moto
